OUR PHILOSOPHY

Our Child Care Philosophy is based on providing a safe and secure learning environment for children to explore through the context of play. We believe that secure relationships with responsive and respectful adults provide a solid foundation for learning. With these positive relationships in place, children can develop the capacity for trust, confidence and independence that help them grow as students and people. Our Child Care program aims to support children's increasing interest in the outdoors, the Arts, dramatic play and more. Our programs are consciously planned to include autonomy and agency, all encompassed within a positive and supportive atmosphere. We value the uniqueness of each child and acknowledge that all children develop their own unique talents and abilities. We nurture each child while working to identify developing areas of interest and exploration.

IMAGE OF THE CHILD

We believe each child is rich in potential, strong, powerful and competent. We support this belief with the provision of an enriching, supportive and inclusive environment enabling the unique needs of each child to be met. We value the rights of children to make choices in their day and be rulers of their own learning. All children will be given the support and encouragement they need to reach their full potential.

CURRICULUM

We believe in a flexible curriculum that will offer a diverse, stimulating and engaging range of experiences reflective of children, family and community. Our program is broadly directed by the outcomes of the Early Years Learning Framework including the development of a child's sense of identity, connectedness with the world, wellbeing, confidence & involvement in learning and communication. We support this belief by providing children with multiple ways to learn both in the indoor and outdoor environments, allowing children to find meaningful connections and relationships in the environment. We respect and value children's' curiosity and questions of wonder and awe. We encourage learning through intentional teaching and natural opportunities in each day. We value and endeavour to always include shared ideas and input to the program from the children and their families.

PARTNERSHIPS

We believe children learn best when strong collaborative relationships exist between the educators themselves as well as between educators, children, their families and the community. We recognise that collaborative relationships lead to strong partnerships. Effective communication is priority at Discovery Kids. This is not only crucial amongst staff but also when communicating with families as well. We believe children need opportunities across their day to explore, investigate and problem solve to build a greater understanding of the world around them. We believe these opportunities enhance children's journey while they are developing greater self-esteem, play skills, social skills and build resilience. We support these beliefs by providing an environment that is engaging, orderly, and pastoral. We support this belief by being available to authentically listen to children and parents' questions and value their contributions to program development. We see ourselves as partners in children's learning and co-explore the learning experiences and unique learning journey of each child.

EDUCATORS

We believe children are inherently curious and interested in the world around them and need diverse experiences to enhance and support their ongoing development.
