- Additional \$5 (incursions), \$10 (excursions) will be charged and noted on your statement (no cash needed).

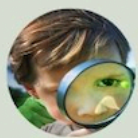
Additional Information

- Parents are required to sign their children in and out.

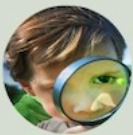
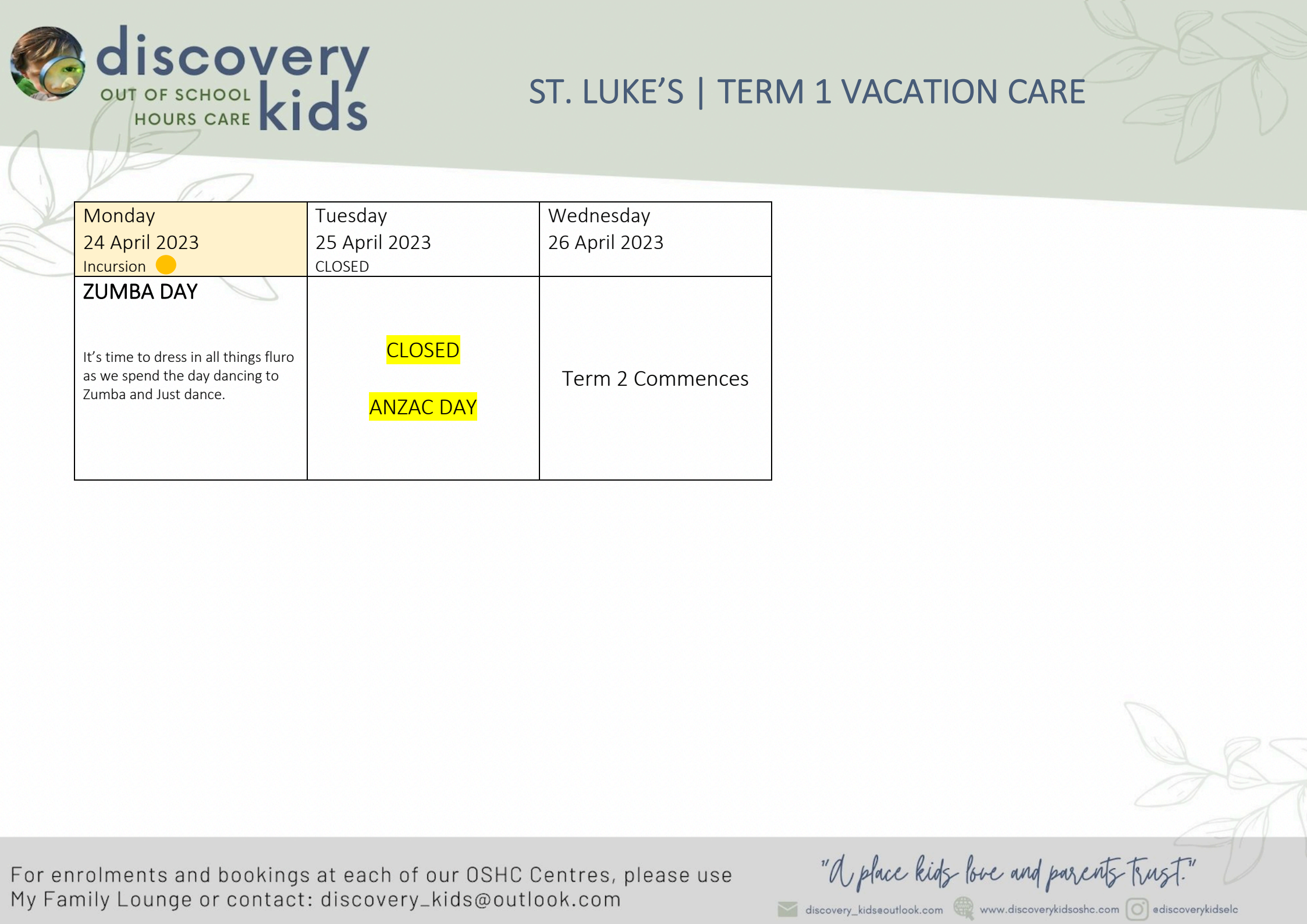
Morning tea and afternoon tea are all provided (please pack your child a healthy Lunch each day and any extra food that you think they will require).

If a child's behaviour affects the safety of other enrolled children, and or educators, parents will be asked to collect their child and make alternative arrangements for them.

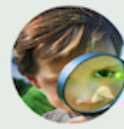
